 - Give your completed form (and fee if relevant) to the Executive Producer.
 - You can pay by EFT: BSB: 325185, Acc No 02243974 Acc name: Galleon Theatre Group Inc. If you’d like to pay by credit card, or cash, that can be arranged. Just let the Executive Producer know.
- **GTG is a legally constituted body** and operates in accordance with a legally binding constitution, which is also available on our “About” page.
- At GTG we expect that everyone involved in our activities will be treated with **respect** and be able to **flourish in a hassle-free environment**. However, we live in an imperfect world and so we have a range of policies and procedures – available for download on the “About” page – that provide us all with pointers and reminders about good practice.
